Dear Ms. Barozzini:

The Department of Health and Mental Hygiene has received a completed application for a license to operate RJ Lee Group, Inc. as a forensic laboratory in accordance with §17-2A-04 of the Health-General Article of the Maryland Code. The Secretary has determined that it is appropriate to grant a temporary license, which is enclosed.

The Secretary made this determination based on the Department's preliminary survey of RJ Lee Group, Inc. conducted on January 18, 2012. The checklist for this preliminary survey and the results this survey are enclosed along with the temporary license.

The temporary license is effective starting January 20, 2012 and is conditional on compliance with the requirements of Title 17, Subtitle 2A of the Health General Article. The license will remain in effect until December 31, 2012. However, if forensic regulations under COMAR 10.51.01-10.51.07 are promulgated and approved before December 31, 2012, your laboratory will be required to comply with and apply for licensure under these regulations. The license should be displayed in a conspicuous place, at or near the entrance to the forensic laboratory, and should be plainly visible to and easily read by the public.

Proposed forensic laboratory regulations are currently under review by the Joint Committee on Administrative, Executive and Legislative Review (the AELR Committee). It is anticipated that the proposed regulations will be printed in the February 10, 2012 Maryland Register, with a period for public comment ending on March 10, 2012.

The Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, Office of Health Care Quality will provide additional information about the status of the proposed regulations during the course of the rulemaking process.


